# **FINANCIAL AID**

**LACM's goal is to provide quality support to all our students and parents needing Financial Aid.** The Financial Aid Office administers various federal, state, and institutional aid programs to help LACM's students finance their education.

#### WHAT IS FEDERAL STUDENT AID?

Federal student aid comes from the federal government, or the U.S. Department of Education. It's money that helps a student pay for education expenses such as tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, and transportation. There are **two main categories** of federal student aid: **grants and loans.**

#### WHY GET A FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN?

Federal student loans offer low fixed interest rates, income-based repayment plans, and deferment (postponement of repayment) options, including deferment of loan payments when a student returns to school. Generally, repayment of a federal loan does not begin until after the student leaves school.

#### WHAT ARE THE GENERAL REQUIREMENTS?

There are several requirements for you to receive federal or state financial aid. A few of the main ones include:

- 1. U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens
- 2. Enrolled in one of the LACM approved programs
- 3. Valid Social Security Number
- 4. High school diploma or equivalent
- 5. Males between the ages of 18 and 26 must be registered with Selective Service
- 6. Maintain satisfactory academic progress while attending LACM
- 7. Satisfactory repayment status of prior Federal student loans
- 8. Satisfactory payment arrangements of prior Federal grant over payments
